#### Introduction

Aldbourne Youth Council welcome you to our grand Auction of Promises, a celebration evening marking the first 6 months use of our brand new Youth and Community Centre 'Community Junction' which Brian Kingham officially opened on 21st September.

The cost to refurbish the building to a useable state was over £220,000.00. We currently have a loan of £25,000.00 and proceeds from the auction will be used towards clearing this debt with any surplus going towards the refurbishment of our much used BMX track, a project completed in 2006.

The Creation of Community Junction:

In late 2011 a chance phone call bought about the new project, Project X! All youth on the council being aware of the negotiations for the building in the Square did not breath a word until final contracts had been signed and the 25-year peppercorn rent lease of the building was theirs on April 17th 2012 thanks to the Kingham Family Trust. Now all that was left was to sort the plans and raise the money! Many meetings took place, ideas were exchanged and finally we had Planning permission.

After only 17 months of removing 200 years of interior, potential asbestos, collapsing walls and 100 tons of the main chimney, Community Junction was officially opened!

Fund raising on a scale we dared not think about! Race night, quiz night, Cake stalls, 100 club and a Comedy night all helped to swell the coffers. Local groups, busineses, villagers all helped either by fund raising or pledging generous donations. Grants were obtained with providers expressing great interest in the project, many calling in to see the development as it progressed and subsequently attending our official opening.

Finally in June 2013 the building was handed over to us to start the internal decorating and finishing. With all hands on deck, we all worked together. The shop itself was completely decorated by our enthusiastic youth councillors and friends.

The Junction now has a one bedroom Holiday Let, a Charity Shop, a chill zone for over 13's, a community area with kitchen and some outside space. The community area is used by numerous clubs, groups for their various activities, from French lessons and Pilates to ukulele and Dressmaking lessons.

A brand new enterprise was born as Community Junction opened called Dreamy Sheep Chocolate. A group of young people with the support of Jenny Martin, an experienced chocolatier meet weekly to create some extraordinary unique luxurious chocolate, which you will have an opportunity to sample for yourselves on the 10th May, attending one of their workshops or placing orders via Community Junction. Other youngsters have enjoyed 24hr stay awake challenges and games nights. Also Community Junction is now officially running as a Duke Of Edinburgh Award centre on Thursday evenings.

Cinema equipment was installed in February 2014 and the charity shop is doing extremely well thanks to our many volunteers who manage it while young people are at school, college or work.

Recycling is now available in Aldbourne Monday to Friday 10am - 3pm and Saturdays 10am - 12:30pm with every penny raised going towards Community Junction running costs ensuring our project remains sustainable and affordable to all.

The holiday let brings visitors to our village from far and wide not only helping us but other local businesses and we have a very enthusiastic cleaning mentor who helps young people to ensure it is looked after properly with plenty of opportunities to get more involved with the management side of our charity work.

Since October 2013 Aldbourne Youth Council has employed 3 part time youth workers who plan youth activities with young people. Last month youngsters enjoyed a trip to the Ice Skating centre in Swindon and are eagerly planning outings for the summer holidays in addition to organising their annual National Play Day event on August 6th.

The Youth Council is for youth, run by youth with adult support and has proved to have made a difference to not only their lives and development of life skills, but also the community as a whole. Jane Scott, leader of Wiltshire Council visited Community Junction in January 2014 and said:

"I cannot tell you how impressed I am with the huge amount of work you and the community have done together in the past few years. If I could only replicate that in every community in Wiltshire it would be fantastic. Please pass on my congratulations to all the team and well done."

Aldbourne Youth Council very much hope you enjoy celebrating with us our successful beginnings on 10th May 2014 and we thank you for your continued support. - (b) All statements whether printed in the catalogue or made orally as to any of the matters set out in (a) above are statements of opinion only and are not to be taken as being or implying any warranties or representations of fact.
- (c) Any claim by a successful bidder must be received by AYC within 7 days of the Auction.

#### 3 The Auction

(a) The highest bidder shall be the buyer except in the case of a dispute. The Auctioneer may at his sole discretion determine the advance of bidding or refuse a bid. If during the auction the Auctioneer considers that a dispute has arisen, he has absolute discretion to settle it or re-offer the lot.

(b) Each lot is put up for sale subject to any reserve price imposed

#### 4 Rescission

There shall be no rescission of any bid after the bid has been accepted by the Auctioneer.

#### 5 Default

Each lot promised has been accepted in good faith by AYC from the individual donor. In the event that any lot is not available at all then AYC will refund the successful bid. The buyer shall not be entitled to any damages or compensation over and above the amount of the bid. In the event of a lot not proving to be as described the buyer shall not be able to rescind his bid or claim damages for any losses whatsoever.


#### 6 Third Party Liability
